### Purpose: To evaluate your spiritual progress in several key relationships

Directions: Rate each statement below with a number 1-5. 1 being *poor* and 5 being *excellent*.

#### 1. My relationship to God

##### a) Faith

##### b) God's Word

##### c) Prayer
