WHAT IS INVOLVED?

1. Weekly meetings which include...
 - a. Bible study
 - b. Accountability concerning Bible memorization and personal worship
 - c. Prayer
2. Bible memorization (approximately 1-2 verses/week)
3. Daily Personal Worship
4. Training so you can disciple someone else

WHAT ARE THE BLESSINGS?

1. Increased knowledge of God's Word
2. Store vital information in your memory (Psalm 119:11)
3. Develop a closer walk with the Lord
4. Prepare you to disciple another
5. Fulfill your responsibilities of Matthew 28:19-20 – "Make Disciples"



WHAT ARE SOME OF THE SPECIFICS?

1. You and your study partner will agree to and sign a Covenant Agreement that commits you to this ministry. It is not for everyone. It will take an effort on your part to get the results intended. It will take COMMITMENT!
2. You and your discipler will be mutually accountable to each other in these areas.
 - a. Daily Bible reading
 - b. Prayer
 - c. Bible memorization
 - d. Trouble areas in your life
 - e. Work involved in the lessons
3. The discipler will not ask you to do something he/she has not done or is not willing to do in connection with this ministry.
4. It is this ministry's goal that you should begin working with someone else (of your same gender), as soon as possible. You will be teaching them what you have learned and are learning. We do not study together just to gain more knowledge, but to equip ourselves to reproduce Christ who is in us in another.
